1 WHEREAS, Mitchell Pavel, a second grader at Weatherford
2 Elementary School in Plano, won first place in his division in the
3 2003 Texas Geography Awareness Week Poster Contest; and

4 WHEREAS, This admirable young man distinguished himself
5 among the more than 1,100 elementary school students from 24
6 schools in Texas who submitted entries in the 2003 competition; and

7 WHEREAS, Sponsored annually by the Texas Alliance for
8 Geographic Education, the statewide contest focused this year on
9 the theme of "Habitats: Home Sweet Home," encouraging participants
10 to explore and illustrate the importance of responsible use,
11 conservation, and preservation of natural habitats; and

12 WHEREAS, It is surely a testimony to the excellence of the
13 school itself as well as to that of the Plano Independent School
14 District that both first-place contest winners in the kindergarten
15 through second grade division and the third through fifth grade
16 division were found among the students of Weatherford Elementary;

18 WHEREAS, Mitchell Pavel's second grade teacher Jeanette
19 Robertson also deserves special recognition for her guidance and
20 leadership; having taught at Weatherford Elementary for 26 years,
21 Ms. Robertson has been named Teacher of the Year three times; and

23 teachers, were invited to attend an awards ceremony on November 17
24 at the Capitol Extension in Austin, where each student was

1 presented with a commemorative medal, a globe, an atlas, and a
2 certificate for a \$100 savings bond; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Pavel is indeed a talented young man who is most
4 certainly deserving of special recognition for this impressive
5 achievement; now, therefore, be it
