R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, In recognition of his outstanding contributions to  
2 his community, the Three Rivers Council of the Boy Scouts of America  
3 has selected Joe Domino of Beaumont as the recipient of the  
4 organization's Distinguished Citizen Award for 2004; and

5           WHEREAS, President and chief executive officer of Entergy  
6 Texas since 1998, Mr. Domino began his career in 1970 as a planning  
7 engineer with Gulf States Utilities, which merged with Entergy in  
8 1994; today, Entergy delivers electricity to 2.6 million utility  
9 customers in Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, and Texas; and

10           WHEREAS, Despite the demands of his career, Mr. Domino has  
11 found time to serve on the boards of numerous civic organizations,  
12 including the Foundation for Southeast Texas, the Lamar University  
13 College of Engineering Advisory Council, the Lamar University  
14 Foundation, the Texas Energy Museum, Christus St. Elizabeth  
15 Hospital, the Symphony of Southeast Texas, and the United Way of  
16 Beaumont and North Jefferson County; he currently serves as  
17 chairman of the Beaumont Chamber of Commerce and as  
18 secretary/treasurer of the Golden Triangle Business Roundtable;

20           WHEREAS, In 2003, Mr. Domino was named president of the Boy  
21 Scouts of America's Southern Region, Area II, which encompasses  
22 portions of West and Southeast Texas and western Louisiana and  
23 oversees 10 Boy Scout councils and 65,000 youth; a longtime  
24 supporter of the Three Rivers Council, Mr. Domino has served on the

1 council's board and has been chosen as a recipient of the  
2 organization's prestigious Silver Antelope Award; and

3 WHEREAS, Many admiring friends, colleagues, and family  
4 members are joining Governor Rick Perry in honoring Joe Domino at  
5 the Three Rivers Council's 21st annual Distinguished Citizen Dinner  
6 on May 20, 2004, for his unwavering dedication to his profession, to  
7 his community, and to the Boy Scouts of America; now, therefore, be

10 Legislature, 4th Called Session, hereby congratulate Joe Domino on
