1 WHEREAS, The passing of Detective Don Palmer of Liberty on
2 April 18, 2004, at the age of 58, deeply saddened the family and
3 friends of this esteemed peace officer; and

4 WHEREAS, A 36-year Texas law enforcement veteran, Officer
5 Palmer served 28 of those years in the narcotics division of the
6 Texas Department of Public Safety and retired as a lieutenant in
7 1996; a month later, he joined the Liberty Police Department as a
8 detective commanding the Chambers-Liberty Counties Narcotic Force;

10 WHEREAS, This distinguished officer, whose advice was
11 regularly sought by rookies and veterans alike, performed in myriad
12 roles and garnered expertise in all aspects of police work as
13 patrol and undercover officer, detective, trainer, supervisor, and
14 administrator; throughout his career, Detective Palmer served his
15 fellow Texans with integrity and dedication, earning the respect
16 and admiration of law enforcement officials across Southwest
17 Texas; and

18 WHEREAS, In addition to being an exemplary peace officer, he
19 was also a devoted family man who deeply loved his wife, Retha; his
20 family may take great pride in his legacy of public service, which
21 will continue to benefit his fellow Texans for many years to come,
22 and they may be comforted in the knowledge that his memory will not
23 soon be forgotten; now, therefore, be it
