11 WHEREAS, Currently, President Judy Schmeltekopf leads the 12 300-woman club, whose membership now includes university faculty, 13 staff, and administrators, as well as wives of Baylor employees; 14 and

WHEREAS, Today, the round table's focus has expanded to include funding an annual scholarship for an outstanding female student and hosting social events such as a Thanksgiving dinner for international students and a Christmas luncheon featuring serenades by Baylor music students; further, members assist individuals new to the faculty as they settle into the close-knit Baylor community; and

WHEREAS, Since 1904, the Baylor Round Table has been a dependable source of support, camaraderie, and fellowship for countless Texas women, and it is a distinct pleasure to join in
