R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Throughout the history of this nation, in times of  
2 great peril, men and women of the United States military have

4           WHEREAS, On April 18, 2004, Lance Corporal Ruben Valdez, Jr.,  
5 of the 3rd Battalion, 7th Marine Regiment, was killed in action

8 Texas, this courageous soldier is remembered for his infectious

13 were demonstrated by this valorous American who gave his life to
