R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, A strong, effective system of free public education  
2 for all youth is essential to our democratic system of government;  
3 and

4           WHEREAS, The United States has made considerable progress in  
5 the social, technological, and scientific fields due to our system  
6 of free and universal public education and to our qualified and  
7 dedicated teachers, who have equipped their students with the  
8 skills necessary to achieve their full potential; and

9           WHEREAS, Given the pivotal role that educators play in the  
10 lives of young people, the National Education Association and the  
11 National Parent Teacher Association are recognizing May 2-8, 2004,  
12 as Teacher Appreciation Week; at this time, it is a pleasure to  
13 honor an outstanding Texas educator, Amancio Rodriguez, for his  
14 exemplary contributions in the field of education; and

15           WHEREAS, A former machinist, Mr. Rodriguez joined the staff  
16 of Economedes High School in Edinburg in 1980 as the metal trades  
17 teacher and has since served his students with great pride and  
18 distinction; involved in a host of professional organizations, he

20 Advisor of the Year and a national finalist in 1995, Outstanding  
21 Region III Career and Technology Teacher for 1985-1986, and
