1 WHEREAS, A strong, effective system of free public education
2 for all youth is essential to our democratic system of government;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, The United States has made considerable progress in
5 the social, technological, and scientific fields due to our system
6 of free and universal public education and to our qualified and
7 dedicated teachers, who have equipped their students with the
8 skills necessary to achieve their full potential; and

9 WHEREAS, Given the pivotal role that educators play in the
10 lives of young people, the National Education Association and the
11 National Parent Teacher Association are recognizing May 2-8, 2004,
12 as Teacher Appreciation Week; at this time, it is a pleasure to
13 honor Mary Santiago for her exemplary contributions in the field of
14 education; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Santiago currently serves as financial aid
16 officer at Edinburg High School, where she has touched the lives of
17 countless young people during her distinguished tenure; and

18 WHEREAS, Her knowledge, experience, and passion for
19 assisting students have enabled her to play a key role in developing
20 and implementing programs that facilitate the transition from high
21 school to a postsecondary institution; among these programs are
22 ACT/SAT academies, junior workshops, financial aid workshops, and
