

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Eleven outstanding young Texans have been selected
2 to participate in the Young Masters Program, a deserving
3 recognition of their commitment to excellence in their chosen art
4 form; and

5 WHEREAS, The Young Masters Program is funded through the
6 Texas Cultural Trust and is administered through a selective grant
7 process by the Texas Commission on the Arts; the program provides
8 scholarships to promising school-age students who engaged in the
9 study of dance, theater, and the visual arts in Texas; each
10 participant receives a scholarship of up to \$2,500 per year for
11 three years to pursue advanced training in his or her artistic
12 discipline; and

13 WHEREAS, Recipients of the Young Masters awards are selected
14 according to the following criteria: their needs due to either
15 limited economic circumstances or geographic isolation; their
16 potential and a high level of aptitude and skill in their chosen
17 field; the quality of their designed plan of study; and the
18 commitment by the student, instructor, and parents to succeed in
19 the program; and

20 WHEREAS, This year's recipients have amply demonstrated
21 their dedication to their artistic discipline, and they have
22 committed themselves to pursuing their talents through intensive
23 training over the next three years; and

24 WHEREAS, These outstanding young men and women are Jonathan
