WHEREAS, Born on July 3, 1921, in Washington, D.C., he served his country in the Pacific theater during World War II as a member of the United States Navy, and during the Korean War he was a flight surgeon at Webb Air Force Base in Big Spring; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Schwartze enrolled at Baylor University after 9 his naval service and met and married the love of his life, the 10 former Mary Buldain; for more than six decades, the couple enjoyed a 11 close and rewarding relationship that was blessed with two children 12 and five cherished grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Following his 1946 graduation from Baylor, Dr.
Schwartze went on to successfully complete the Bowman Gray School of Medicine at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, as well as his residency at Houston's Hermann Hospital;

18 WHEREAS, This esteemed physician began his medical practice 19 in 1954 at the South Waco Clinic, where he worked to protect and 20 preserve the health of generations of Central Texans until his 21 retirement in 2001; moreover, he was a valued member of the staff at 22 Providence Health Center and Hillcrest Baptist Medical Center; and

23 WHEREAS, Despite a demanding schedule, he also made time to 24 enjoy the fellowship of others and to serve the community as a 32nd

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Schwartze demonstrated great dedication to his 3 patients and profession throughout his exemplary medical career, 4 and he will long be remembered by all who were privileged to know 5 him; now, therefore, be it
