R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Angleton Lions Club is celebrating its 75th  
2 anniversary on May 15, 2004, and this occasion presents an ideal  
3 opportunity to commend this group for its contributions to the city  
4 of Angleton; and

5           WHEREAS, Throughout the decades, the Angleton Lions Club has  
6 been an integral part of its community; it has been deeply involved  
7 in activities ranging from distributing food baskets to sponsoring  
8 youth sports teams and has organized events such as talent shows,
