9 grade at Leoline Horton Elementary and fifth grade science at
10 Louise Black Elementary before serving as a counselor and then
11 moving into education administration; and

12 WHEREAS, In 1977, he became principal at Louise Black
13 Elementary, and during his tenure the school won a 1987-1988 "Just
14 Say No" National Award; he was also coprincipal at Roosevelt
15 Elementary School and principal at Horton Elementary, the Weslaco
16 ISD Guidance Center, the Stephen F. Austin prekindergarten program
17 campus, and Cleckler-Heald Elementary; and

18 WHEREAS, A respected administrator, Mr. Saénz has served the
19 Weslaco ISD with integrity and dedication; he has earned the
20 lasting respect of all who have been fortunate enough to work with
21 him, and it is a pleasure to honor him as he embarks on this exciting
22 new chapter in his life; now, therefore, be it
