1 WHEREAS, The citizens of Winnsboro lost a valued friend and
2 much-admired public servant with the passing of city council member
3 Barney Fred Anderson on May 3, 2004, at the age of 75; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Anderson graduated from Winnsboro High School
5 and pursued his higher education at the University of North Texas
6 before proudly serving his country in the U.S. Army; and

7 WHEREAS, He was a marketing wholesale representative who had
8 worked for Texaco for 34 years; after he retired, the Andersons
9 returned to Winnsboro, and in 1998, he was elected to the Winnsboro
10 City Council, where he served three distinguished terms before his
11 passing; and

12 WHEREAS, He further donated his time and talents to the
13 Presbyterian Hospital of Winnsboro board of directors, the
14 Winnsboro Planning and Zoning Board, the Winnsboro Economic
15 Development Board, the Upper Sabine Valley Waste Management
16 District board, Meals on Wheels Ministry, and the American Music
17 Festival; and

18 WHEREAS, A member of the First United Methodist Church, he
19 had served in a number of positions over the years, including
20 finance chairman, president of his Sunday school class,
21 pastor-parish relations chairman, and member of the choir; and

22 WHEREAS, Barney Anderson gave unstintingly of his talents,
23 time, and efforts, and his commitment to achieving an ever brighter
24 future for the citizens of his community represented the very best

1 in public service; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
3 Legislature, 4th Called Session, hereby honor the life of Barney
4 Fred Anderson and extend deepest sympathy to his family: to his
5 wife, Margie Faye Anderson; to his daughter, Tina Carol Davis; to

7 grandchildren; to his sister, Wanda Allen Martin; and to the other
