[(ii) retires on or before August 31, 2009; 1 [(iii) at the time of retirement, meets the 2 requirements for eligibility for the group program for coverage as 3 a retiree as those requirements existed on August 31, 2004, 4 5 including using up to five years of out-of-state service toward retiree eligibility; and 6 7 [(iv) has taken a service retirement under 8 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas without reduction for early 9 age; [(D)] has taken a service retirement under the 10 Teacher Retirement System of Texas and: 11 (i) who has at least 10 years of service 12 credit in the system, which may include up to five years of military 13 service credit but which may not include any other service credit 14 15 purchased for equivalent or special service credit; $[\tau]$ and (ii) the sum of whose [the individual's] age 16 and amount of any service credit in the system, including service 17 credit purchased for equivalent or special service credit, 18 [described by this paragraph] equals or exceeds the number 80; or 19 (D) [(E)] has taken a service retirement under 20 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas on or before August 31, 2004, 21 and who is enrolled in the group program on August 31, 2004; or 22 (2) an individual who: 23 24 (A) has taken a disability retirement under the Teacher Retirement System of Texas; and 25 is entitled to receive monthly benefits from 26 (B) 27 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.

1 (b) Each year of service credit in the system that an 2 individual would have received but for the individual's 3 participation in the deferred retirement option plan under 4 Subchapter I, Chapter 824, Government Code, is considered a year of 5 service credit solely for the purpose of meeting the definition of 6 "retiree" under Subsection (a)(1)(A) or <u>(C)</u> [(D)].

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2004.
