| 11 | district shall file a written report of the district's strategy     |
| 12 | with the agency and the State Board for Educator Certification.     |
| 13 | (b) Not later than January 1, 2006, the agency and the State        |
| 14 | Board for Educator Certification shall prepare and submit a report  |
| 15 | to the legislature based on the teacher recruitment and retention   |
| 16 | strategies received from districts under Subsection (a).            |
| 17 | (c) The agency and the State Board for Educator                     |
| 18 | Certification shall adopt guidelines for the implementation of this |
| 19 | section.  |
| 20 | (d) This section expires January 31, 2006.                          |
| 21 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives         |
| 22 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as   |
