11. In Article III, add the following appropriately numbered rider under the appropriations to the Texas Education Agency:

Basic Skills Programs for High School Students. Out of funds appropriated above in Strategy A.2.2, Student Success, the Commissioner of Education shall, in a manner consistent with Texas Education Code §29.086, allocate \$32,025,000 in 2004 and \$32,025,000 in 2005 as grants to school districts implementing special programs for students in grade 9 who have not earned sufficient credit to advance to grade 10 and who do not meet the Commissioner's established minimum skill levels. any unexpended balances as of August 31, 2004. are appropriated for the same purpose for the 2005 fiscal year.
