Amend HB 261 (Senate committee printing) as follows:

(1) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in the introductory language, immediately before "adding Subsection (j)" (page 1, at the beginning of line 13), insert "amending Subsections (c), (f), and (g) and".

(2) In SECTION 1 of the bill, immediately before proposed Subsection (j), Section 54.058, Education Code (page 1, between lines 13 and 14), insert the following:

(c) <u>The</u> [As long as they reside continuously in Texas, the] spouse <u>or child</u> [and children] of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States who has been assigned to duty elsewhere immediately following assignment to duty in Texas <u>is</u> [are] entitled to pay the tuition fees and other fees or charges provided for Texas residents <u>as long as the spouse or child resides continuously in</u> <u>Texas</u>.

(f) The spouse <u>or child</u> [and children] of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States who dies or is killed <u>is</u> [are] entitled to pay the resident tuition fee if the <u>spouse or child</u> <u>becomes a resident</u> [wife and children become residents] of Texas within 60 days of the date of death.

(g) If a member of the Armed Forces of the United States is stationed outside Texas and <u>the member's</u> [his] spouse <u>or child</u> <u>establishes</u> [and children establish] residence in Texas by residing in Texas and by filing with the Texas institution of higher education at which <u>the spouse or child plans</u> [they plan] to register a letter of intent to establish residence in Texas, the institution of higher education shall permit the spouse <u>or child</u> [and children] to pay the tuition, fees, and other charges provided for Texas residents without regard to length of time that <u>the spouse or child</u> <u>has</u> [they have] resided in <u>Texas</u> [the state].

(3) In SECTION 2 of the bill, immediately before "Section 54.058(j)" (page 1, line 29), insert "(a)".

(4) At the end of SECTION 2 of the bill (page 1, between lines 37 and 38), insert the following:

"(b) The changes in law made by this Act to Subsections (c), (f), and (g), Section 54.058, Education Code, apply beginning with tuition charged for the 2003 fall semester."
