## **BILL ANALYSIS**

H.B. 2334 By: Turner Land & Resource Management Committee Report (Unamended)

## **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

Current law allows voters of an area annexed by a municipality for limited purposes to vote in elections for mayor and city council. Some municipalities elect their city controller.

H.B. 2334 will authorize voters in an area annexed by a municipality for limited purposes to also vote in elections for city controller if the office is an elective position of the municipality.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

It is the committee's opinion that this bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, department, agency, or institution.

## **ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Authorizes voters in an area annexed by a municipality for limited purposes to vote

in elections for city controller if the office is an elective position of the municipality.

SECTION 2. Effective date.
