# BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

The Sarita Federal Checkpoint is located in Kennedy County. With the ever growing traffic on U.S. Highway 77, this checkpoint now generates many forfeiture cases. Kenedy County has around 500 residents and minimal court resources. Allowing cases to be heard in other counties could ease the burden on Kenedy County Courts caused by the presence of the checkpoint. C.S.H.B. 3377 would allow certain cases to be held in an adjacent county under certain circumstances.
