DIGEST AND PURPOSE

As proposed, S.B. 8 creates the Colony Municipal Utility District No. 1 and provides for its administration, powers, duties, operation and financing. This bill provides a means of extending centralized water and wastewater utility to an area where those services are not currently available and facilitates the development of a high-quality residential community.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.
