## **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently, Texas faces a difficult challenge to develop water policies that serve state and regional interests. As proposed, S.B. 25 creates the Kennedy Groundwater Conservation District, subject to approval at a confirmation election, to manage groundwater resources in Kennedy County.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.
