#### **BILL ANALYSIS**

S.B. 708 By: Jackson County Affairs Committee Report (Unamended)

## **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

Current state law authorizes the commissioners court of a county to prohibit or regulate the keeping of wild animals. S.B. 708 clarifies that the commissioners court can delegate that authority to public health districts.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

It is the committee's opinion that this bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, department, agency, or institution.

#### **ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 240.002, Local Government Code, by adding Subsection (c) to authorize a commissioners court of a county to delegate the authority granted under Subsection (a)to a county health department or a public health district established under Subchapter E, Chapter121, Health and Safety Code (Local Public Health Reorganization Act).

SECTION 2. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2003.
