## DIGEST AND PURPOSE

Currently, Texas law provides for issuance of a special license plate for disabled veterans with at least 60 percent service-connected disability or 40 percent service connected disability because of the amputation of a lower extremity. The license plate is a plain white plate with blue lettering and contains the letters "DV" as a prefix or suffix. As proposed, S.B. 730 honors veterans with a license plate which contains a more patriotic design selected by members of the disabled veterans community.

## RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Amends Section 502.254, Transportation Code, to limit the license plates for disabled veterans to three colors and to provide that they be of a color, quality, and design selected by a five-member design board consisting of certain persons.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2003.
