## **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Under current Texas law, the Department of Public Safety (DPS) does not have the specific authority to approve computer-based driver education programs. As proposed, S.B. 895 does not require DPS to develop or approve computer-based driver education programs, but allows DPS to approve an alternative program under existing procedures. S.B. 895 specifies that such alternative programs can include electronic methods.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

Rulemaking authority previously granted to the Texas Department of Public Safety is modified in SECTION 1 (Section 521.205, Transportation Code) of this bill.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 521.205(c), Transportation Code, by adding Subdivision (3) to provide that certain rules adopted by the Department of Public Safety must provide a method by which approval for delivering course materials by an alternative method, including electronic means, is obtained.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2003.
