### **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Currently, a registry of the court may accept child support payments only by personal check, cashier's check, money order, and electronic funds transfer. C.S.S.B. 1501 authorizes a local registry to accept child support payments made by credit card, debit card, or automatic teller machine (ATM) card.

# **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 154.241, Family Code, by adding Subsection (f) to authorize a local registry to accept child support payments made by credit card, debit card, or ATM card.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2003.

## **SUMMARY OF COMMITTEE CHANGES**

SECTION 1. Differs from the original by adding "debit card, or ATM card" to proposed text.
