### **BILL ANALYSIS**

S.B. 1603 By: Ellis, Rodney Land & Resource Management Committee Report (Unamended)

## **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

The General Land Office is charged with the preservation of Texas' historic maps and supporting documents. In 2000, the General Land Office created the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program to allow Texans to make tax deductible contributions for the preservation of the agency's important historic maps and documents.

S.B. 1603 proposes adding the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program to the State Employee's Charitable Campaign Program (SECC). Currently, the Parks and Wildlife Foundation of Texas, Inc. and the Bob Bullock State History Museum participate in the SECC.

# **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

It is the committee's opinion that this bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, department, agency, or institution.

#### **ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Natural Resources Code, by adding Section 31.0655 as follows:

Allows the General Land Office to be considered a charitable organization entitled to participate in the state employee charitable campaign for the purpose of managing the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program.

Authorizes a state employee to authorize a deduction for contributions to the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program.

SECTION 2. Authorizes the General Land Office to participate in the program during the autumn of 2003.

SECTION 3. Effective date.

## **EFFECTIVE DATE**

September 1, 2003 unless the Act receives the vote necessary for immediate effect.
