DIGEST AND PURPOSE

Current Texas law establishes the procedures for creation, administration, and dissolution of fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services districts in certain municipalities. As proposed, S.B. 1777 repeals language defining “governing body” in the Local Government Code.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Repealer: Subsection 344.052(e), Subchapter B, Chapter 344, Local Government Code (Temporary Board).

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2003.
