DIGEST AND PURPOSE

Currently, Jasper and Newton counties do not have a groundwater conservation district. S.B. 1888 creates the Southeast Texas Groundwater Conservation District to serve Jasper and Newton counties. The district will have powers commonly granted to conservation districts.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.
