DIGEST AND PURPOSE

As proposed, S.B. 1916 creates the Colony Municipal Utility District No. 1 and provides for its administration, powers, duties, operation and financing. This bill provides a means of extending centralized water and wastewater utility to an area where those services are not currently available and facilitates the development of high quality residential community.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.
