DIGEST AND PURPOSE

As proposed, S.B. 1922 creates a conservation and reclamation district, to be known as the Garfield Municipal Utility District No. 1, in Bastrop County, subject to approval by the City of Bastrop and to approval at a confirmation election under Section 12 of this Act.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.
