DIGEST AND PURPOSE

As proposed, S.B. 1956 creates the Fourth Ward Management District as a political subdivision of the State of Texas to administer and provide funding for community improvement projects and services in certain commercial areas. The district will be a municipal district similar to those operating pursuant to Chapters 375 and 376, Local Government Code.
