A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the use of dedicated revenue during a state budget
3	crisis.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 403.0955 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 403.0955. USE OF DEDICATED REVENUE DURING STATE BUDGET
8	CRISIS. (a) Notwithstanding any law dedicating or setting aside
9	revenue for a particular purpose or entity, revenue that has been
10	set aside by law for a particular purpose or entity is available for
11	general governmental purposes:
12	(1) during a current biennium if the comptroller
13	certifies that appropriations from general revenue made by the
14	preceding legislature for the current biennium exceed available
15	general revenues and cash balances for the remainder of the current
16	biennium; and
17	(2) during the succeeding biennium if an estimate of
18	anticipated revenues for the succeeding biennium prepared by the
19	comptroller pursuant to Article III, Section 49a, Texas
20	Constitution is less than the revenues that are estimated at the
21	same time by the comptroller to be available for the current
22	biennium.
23	(b) Revenue described by Subsection (a) is considered
24	available for the purpose of certification under Section 403.121.

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1	(c) This section does not apply to revenues or balances in:
2	(1) funds outside the treasury;
3	(2) trust funds;
4	(3) funds created by the constitution or a court; or
5	(4) funds for which separate accounting is required by
6	federal law.
7	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
8	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
9	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
10	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

11 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
