- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 501, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 501.114 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 501.114. DURATION OF PLACEMENT IN ADMINISTRATIVE
 9 SEGREGATION. (a) The department shall establish procedures that
 10 require the department to transfer from administrative segregation
 11 to the general population an inmate who has been in administrative
- 12 segregation for five or more consecutive years.
- 13 (b) The procedures must permit an inmate who would otherwise

 14 be transferred to the general population because of the length of

 15 the inmate's placement in administrative segregation to decline the
- 16 transfer.

- (c) Procedures adopted under this section are not required
- 18 to prohibit the department from returning an inmate to
- 19 administrative segregation because of disciplinary or safety
- 20 <u>issues related to the inmate.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. (a) Under procedures adopted as required by
- 22 Section 501.114, Government Code, as added by this Act, an inmate
- 23 who on or before September 1, 2004, has been in administrative
- 24 segregation for five or more consecutive years, must be transferred

- 1 before September 1, 2005, to the general population.
- 2 (b) Subsection (a) of this section does not apply to an
- 3 inmate who under procedures adopted under Section 501.114,
- 4 Government Code, as added by this Act, declines transfer to the
- 5 general population.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
