- 125.067(b) or (c) may issue an injunctive order under this 11
- 12 subchapter that expires not later than the 180th day after the date
- a temporary injunctive order is issued under Section 125.065. 13
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to an action brought under
- Subchapter D, Chapter 125, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, as 16
- amended by this Act, that is commenced on or after the effective 17
- date of this Act. An action that is commenced before the effective 18
- date of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the suit 19
- immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is 20
- 21 continued in effect for that purpose.
