A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to coverage for certain prescriptions to stop smoking 3 under the Texas Employees Group Benefits Act. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 1551.205, Insurance Code, as effective 5 6 June 1, 2003, is amended to read as follows: Sec. 1551.205. LIMITATIONS. The board of trustees may not 7 contract for or provide a coverage plan that: 8 9 (1)excludes or limits coverage or services for acquired immune deficiency syndrome, as defined by the Centers for 10 Disease Control and Prevention of the United States Public Health 11 12 Service, or human immunodeficiency virus infection; [or] 13 (2) provides coverage for serious mental illness that 14 is less extensive than the coverage provided for any physical 15 illness; or (3) provides coverage for prescription drugs to assist 16 in stopping smoking at a lower benefit level than is provided for 17 18 other prescription drugs. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 19 to coverage contracted for or provided by the board of trustees 20 21 established under Chapter 815, Government Code, to administer the 22 Employees Retirement System of Texas on or after September 1, 2004. Coverage contracted for or provided by the board of trustees before 23 September 1, 2004, is governed by the law in effect immediately 24

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
