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- 2 relating to policy forms for personal fire and homeowners
- 3 insurance.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 5.35, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (k), (1), and (m) to read as follows:
- 7 (k) Each insurer that writes homeowners insurance in this
- 8 state shall offer homeowners coverage written through the HO-B
- 9 policy form, as adopted by the commissioner and in effect on January
- 10 1, 2003, or a policy form that offers equivalent coverage, as
- 11 determined by the commissioner.
- 12 (1) An insurer shall make available to consumers a
- 13 side-by-side comparison of each policy form of personal fire and
- 14 homeowners insurance subject to this article that is offered by the
- insurer. The commissioner may adopt rules governing the form and
- 16 content of the side-by-side comparisons required by this
- 17 subsection.
- 18 (m) This article applies to each insurer that writes a
- 19 policy of personal fire or homeowners insurance in this state,
- 20 including a farm mutual insurance company and a reciprocal or
- 21 interinsurance exchange.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 23 applies only to an insurance policy that is delivered, issued for
- 24 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2004. A policy that is

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- 1 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2004,
- 2 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 3 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 4 this purpose.
