2	relating to programs to reduce truancy in certain school districts.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 25.096 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 25.096. TRUANCY REDUCTION PROGRAM. (a) A school
7	district shall establish a program to reduce truancy at a district
8	campus if the student attendance rate at the campus is below 94
9	percent for at least two consecutive months.
10	(b) A district required to establish a program under this
11	section shall:
12	(1) operate the program at least until the monthly
13	student attendance rate at the campus is at or above 94 percent;
14	(2) designate one or more district employees as
15	truancy caseworkers; and
16	(3) require the employee or employees designated under
17	Subdivision (2) to:
18	(A) promptly notify parents of students who are
19	absent from school without excuse;
20	(B) work cooperatively with parents and students
21	to improve student attendance;
22	(C) closely monitor the school attendance of
23	students with a history of unexcused absences; and
24	(D) refer students with a history of unexcused

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absences and the parents of those students to any appropriate 1 2 programs or services available to address the underlying causes of 3 the failure to attend school. 4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004 5 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8

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9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
