## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to offenses involving dogs that are a danger to livestock
- 3 and other animals.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 822, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Section 822.011(a), transferring Sections 822.033 and
- 7 822.034 to Subchapter B, renumbering those sections as Sections
- 8 822.012 and 822.013, respectively, and amending those sections, and
- 9 adding Section 822.014 to read as follows:
- 10 (a) The owner, keeper, or person in control of a dog that the
- owner, keeper, or person knows is accustomed to run, worry, or kill
- 12 goats, sheep, [ex] poultry, calves, or other livestock may not
- 13 permit the dog to run at large.
- 14 Sec. 822.012 [822.033]. DOGS THAT ATTACK DOMESTIC ANIMALS.
- 15 (a) A dog that is attacking, is about to attack, or has recently
- 16 attacked sheep, goats, calves, or other <u>livestock or</u> domestic
- 17 animals or fowls may be killed by any person witnessing or having
- 18 knowledge of the attack.
- 19 (b) A person who kills a dog as provided by this section is
- 20 not liable for damages to the owner of the dog.
- (c) A dog known or suspected of having killed sheep, goats,
- 22 calves, or other livestock or domestic animals or fowls is a public
- 23 nuisance. Any person may detain or impound the dog until the dog's
- owner is notified and all damage done by the dog has been determined

- 1 and paid to the proper persons.
- 2 (d) The owner of a dog that is known to have attacked sheep,
- 3 goats, calves, or other <u>livestock or</u> domestic animals or fowls
- 4 shall kill the dog. [A sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, police
- 5 officer, magistrate, or county commissioner may enter the premises
- 6 of the owner of the dog and kill the dog if the owner fails to do
- 7 <del>so.</del>]
- 8 Sec. 822.013 [822.034]. PROTECTION OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS.
- 9 The owner of any sheep, goats, calves, or other livestock or
- 10 domestic animals that are subject to the ravages of [sheep-killing]
- dogs that kill livestock or domestic animals may place poison on the
- 12 premises where the animals are kept. The owner must post notice of
- 13 the poison at each entrance to the premises before placing the
- 14 poison.
- Sec. 822.014. EXOTIC LIVESTOCK INCLUDED. In this
- 16 <u>subchapter</u>, "livestock" includes exotic livestock as defined by
- 17 Section 161.001, Agriculture Code.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 822.011(a), Health and Safety Code, applies only to an offense
- 20 committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense
- 21 committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the
- law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is
- 23 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
- 24 an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if
- 25 any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
