- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 552.140 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 552.140. MILITARY DISCHARGE RECORDS. (a) A military
 10 veteran's Department of Defense Form DD-214 or other military
 11 discharge record that has been recorded with or that is otherwise in
 12 the possession of a governmental body is excepted from required
 13 public disclosure.
- 14 <u>(b) A governmental body may allow only the following</u>
 15 <u>persons, on presentation of proper identification, to inspect or</u>
 16 receive a copy of the form or other military discharge record:
- 19 (2) the spouse, the natural or adopted child, or the 20 parent of the veteran.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
