- 6 amended by adding Section 431.017 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 431.017. CERTAIN BENEFITS AND PROTECTIONS FOR STATE
- 8 SERVICE. A member of the state military forces who is ordered to
- 9 active state duty by the governor or by other proper authority under
- 10 the law of this state is entitled to the same benefits and
- 11 protections provided:
- 12 (1) to persons performing service in the uniformed
- 13 services by 38 U.S.C. Sections 4301-4313 and 4316-4319, as that law
- existed on April 1, 2003; and
- 15 (2) to persons in the military service of the United
- 16 States by 50 App. U.S.C. Sections 501-536, 560, and 580-594, as that
- 17 law existed on April 1, 2003.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to persons serving on
- 19 active state duty on or after the effective date of this Act without
- 20 regard to the date on which the person was initially ordered to
- 21 active state duty.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
