## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 431, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 431.017 to read as follows:
- Sec. 431.017. CERTAIN BENEFITS AND PROTECTIONS FOR STATE 7
- SERVICE. A member of the state military forces who is ordered to 8
- 9 active state duty by the governor or by other proper authority under
- the law of this state is entitled to the same benefits and 10
- 11 protections provided:
- 12 (1) to persons performing service in the uniformed
- 13 services by 38 U.S.C. Sections 4301-4313 and 4316-4319, as that law
- 14 existed on April 1, 2003; and
- 15 (2) to persons in the military service of the United
- States by 50 App. U.S.C. Sections 501-536, 560, and 580-594, as that 16
- law existed on April 1, 2003. 17
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and 18
- applies only to persons serving on active state duty on or after 19
- that date without regard to the date on which the person was 20
- 21 initially ordered to active state duty.
