## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to the authority of the Texas Department of Transportation
3	to purchase or condemn real property for the Trans-Texas Corridor.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter N to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER N. TRANS-TEXAS CORRIDOR
8	Sec. 201.961. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "Trans-Texas
9	Corridor" means the multiuse, statewide transportation corridor
10	described by the department's implementation plan adopted by the
11	commission on June 27, 2002.
12	Sec. 201.962. ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY. (a) Subject to
13	the availability of funds appropriated by the legislature, the
14	department may purchase or condemn real property necessary or
15	convenient for the Trans-Texas Corridor, including purchasing or
16	condemning real property for highway, railway, or utility purposes.
17	(b) The authority to purchase or condemn real property under
18	Subsection (a) includes the authority to acquire a right-of-way
19	that may be leased by the department to a private entity for profit.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
