1-8 relating to the number of members of an appraisal review board.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 6.41(b), Tax Code, is amended to read as
1-11 follows:

1-12 (b) The board consists of three members. However, the
1-13 district board of directors by resolution of a majority of its
1-14 members may increase the size of the appraisal review board to the
1-15 number of members the board of directors considers appropriate [~~not~~
1-16 ~~more than nine members or, in a district established for a county~~
1-17 ~~with a population of at least 250,000, to not more than 40 members~~
1-18 ~~or, in a district established for a county with a population of at~~
1-19 ~~least 500,000, to not more than 75 members~~].

1-20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2004.
