- 12 SECTION 2. Section 53.124(e), Property Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- (e) The time of inception of a lien that is created under
- 15 Section 53.021(c), [er] (d), or (e) is the date of recording of an
- 16 affidavit of lien under Section 53.052. The priority of a lien
- claimed by a person entitled to a lien under Section 53.021(c), [or]
- 18 (d), or (e) with respect to other mechanic's liens is determined by
- 19 the date of recording. A lien created under Section 53.021(c)<sub> $\underline{r}$ </sub> [ $\underline{or}$ ]
- 20 (d), or (e) is not valid or enforceable against a grantee or
- 21 purchaser who acquires an interest in the real property before the
- 22 time of inception of the lien.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 24 applies only to labor performed or labor or materials furnished
