A PEACE OFFICER WHO RELIES ON THE TERMS OF 13 A COURT ORDER AND THE OFFICER'S AGENCY ARE ENTITLED TO THE 14 APPLICABLE IMMUNITY AGAINST ANY CLAIM, CIVIL OR OTHERWISE, 15 16 REGARDING THE OFFICER'S GOOD FAITH ACTS PERFORMED IN THE SCOPE OF THE OFFICER'S DUTIES IN ENFORCING THE TERMS OF THE ORDER THAT RELATE 17 18 TO CHILD CUSTODY. ANY PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY PRESENTS FOR ENFORCEMENT AN ORDER THAT IS INVALID OR NO LONGER IN EFFECT COMMITS 19 AN OFFENSE THAT MAY BE PUNISHABLE BY CONFINEMENT IN JAIL FOR AS LONG 20 21 AS TWO YEARS AND A FINE OF AS MUCH AS \$10,000."
