A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the punishment for criminal mischief committed by

- 3 intentionally introducing infectious diseases into livestock.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.03, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(i) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), an offense under this</u>
- 8 section is a felony of the first degree if the property is livestock
- 9 and the damage is caused by introducing bovine spongiform
- 10 encephalopathy, commonly known as mad cow disease, or a disease
- 11 <u>described</u> by <u>Section 161.041(a)</u>, <u>Agriculture Code</u>. <u>In this</u>
- 12 <u>subsection</u>, "livestock" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 13 <u>161.001</u>, Agriculture Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 16 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 17 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 18 before the effective date.
- 19 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 20 Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
