A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to venue in the prosecution of the offense of fraudulent
- 3 use or possession of identifying information.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 13, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 13.28 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 13.28. FRAUDULENT USE OR POSSESSION OF IDENTIFYING
- 8 INFORMATION. An offense under Section 32.51, Penal Code, may be
- 9 prosecuted in any county in which the offense was committed or in
- 10 the county of residence for the person whose identifying
- information was fraudulently obtained, possessed, transferred, or
- 12 <u>used.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 14 applies only to the prosecution of an offense commenced by the
- 15 filing of an indictment or information on or after that date. A
- 16 prosecution commenced before September 1, 2003, is controlled by
- 17 the law in effect at the time the prosecution was commenced, and the
- 18 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
