- (b) A contribution under this section may be any amount that is equal to or less than the difference between the amount the state is required to contribute under Section 830.201 to the benefit of each participant employed by the institution of higher education and the amount the state appropriates for that purpose.
- 18 (c) The governing board of an institution of higher
  19 education may contribute an amount under this section to the
  20 benefit of a participant employed by an institution of higher
  21 education on or before August 31, 1995, that is different from the
  22 amount the governing board contributes to the benefit of a
  23 participant employed by an institution of higher education after
  24 that date.
