A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the collection, analysis, and dissemination of 3 information relating to certain sexual offenses. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 411, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 411.049 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 411.049. SEXUAL ASSAULT REPORTING. (a) The department shall establish and maintain a central repository for 8 the collection and analysis of information relating to the 9 commission of an offense under Section 22.011 or 22.021, Penal 10 Code, including information regarding the victim and the 11 12 perpetrator of the offense and information indicating the results of any forensic medical examination described by Article 56.06, 13 14 Code of Criminal Procedure, and the results of any prosecution of the offense. On establishing the repository, the department shall 15 develop a procedure to monitor, record, classify, and analyze 16 information under this subsection. 17 18 (b) Local law enforcement agencies shall report the commission of offenses under Sections 22.011 and 22.021, Penal 19 Code, and other related information required by Subsection (a) in 20 21 the form and manner and at regular intervals as prescribed by rules adopted by the department. The department shall summarize and 22 23 analyze information received under this subsection and any other 24 corresponding information possessed by the department.

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(c) The department shall make information, records, and 1 2 statistics collected under this section available to any local law enforcement agency, political subdivision, or state agency to the 3 4 extent the information is reasonably necessary or useful to the agency or subdivision in carrying out duties imposed by law on the 5 6 agency or subdivision. This subsection may not be construed to limit access to information, records, or statistics if access is 7 permitted by other law. Dissemination of the names of perpetrators 8 and victims is subject to all confidentiality requirements 9 otherwise imposed by law. 10 SECTION 2. The Department of Public Safety of the State of 11 Texas shall establish the rules and procedures necessary to comply 12 with Section 411.049, Government Code, as added by this Act, not 13

- 14 later than October 1, 2003.
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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
