- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 172.021, Election Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 8 (g) A candidate for the office of chief justice or justice,
- 9 supreme court, or presiding judge or judge, court of criminal
- 10 appeals, who chooses to pay the filing fee must also accompany the
- 11 application with a petition that complies with the requirements
- 12 prescribed for a petition authorized by Subsection (b), except that
- the minimum number of signatures that must appear on the petition
- 14 required by this subsection is 50 from each court of appeals
- 15 district.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
