- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 261, Family Code, is
- amended by adding Section 261.005 to read as follows: 7
- 8 Sec. 261.005. REFUSAL OF PSYCHIATRIC OR PSYCHOLOGICAL
- TREATMENT OF CHILD. The refusal of a parent, guardian, or managing 9
- or possessory conservator of a child to administer or consent to the 10
- 11 administration of a psychotropic drug to the child, or to consent to
- 12 any other psychiatric or psychological treatment of the child, does
- 13 not by itself constitute neglect under this subtitle unless the
- 14 refusal to consent presents an imminent physical risk of serious
- harm to the child. 15
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19
- Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 20
